Scholar Season Tickets

Train ticket discounts are available for all ages, 16 to 19-year-olds in full-time education could save 50% on Season Tickets valid for a complete term or academic year.

Travel must be between any two stations within the Greater Anglia network and excludes Travelcard and Oyster areas.

Term tickets

Available 3 times a year at the beginning of each term. (Autumn, Spring and Summer terms)

Academic year

Available at the beginning of each school year, valid from 31 July to 31 May the following year.

Academic year tickets are cheaper than buying 3 Term tickets.

We also offer a short academic year which expires on 31 May for students who are going on study leave or taking exams.

Monthly direct debit

This comprises of 8 or 10 direct debit payments following an initial payment at the time of the order. Tickets are then uploaded to a monthly Smartcard which must be activated each month.



Example fares

Dovercourt to Colchester for a 16-year-old.

Term ticket: £274.80, this would be the same for each term. $3 \times £274.80 = £824.40$.

Academic year ticket: £763.70 valid from Mid-august to 31 July saving £60.70 over the year.

Monthly direct debit: First payment made when ordering, £119.40 plus 9 more payments of the same amount, a total of £1194 over the school year.

Smart Cards

Most of our tickets are now sold on Smart Cards. All scholar tickets will be loaded to a Business Travel Smart Card. We advise students to keep this card for every term and they will be asked to quote the long number on the card with every order they make.

Your Smart Card can be activated via the Greater Anglia App on any NFC enabled phone. Download the App, click on Smart Card then simply hold the card against the NFC area on the back of the phone. The details of the ticket will show up on your phone when it has been activated.



Or it can be activated at a chosen station. For more information on Smart Cards visit greateranglia.co.uk/smart.



Photo ID cards

Before you order your season ticket, you'll need a valid railway photo ID card. You can get your card, free of charge, from any staffed railway ticket office.

The adult rate photocard (16 or over) is the pink example shown. You will need to provide a passport size photograph.

The child rate photocard (aged 5-15 when the term starts) is the yellow example shown. You will also need a passport size photograph and a copy of your birth certificate, you can also get these, free of charge, from any staffed railway ticket office.



PlusBus



If you travel to the station by bus, you could save money on your bus fare by adding PlusBus to your Scholar Season ticket.
