Academic writing support

This covers everything related to written assignments like essays, reports or creating presentation slides. Typical subjects for 1-to-1 sessions and workshops include developing a suitable academic writing style, organising your writing and correctly using references to avoid plagiarism. Academic writing support is available to students throughout their time with us, helping students stay on track to achieve their qualifications. It can be especially useful during your first year when writing degree-level assignments may be new and challenging.

Digital IT skills for study

Our IT skills support includes a rolling schedule of training sessions and small workshops across all levels of IT ability. Topics include formatting assignments and dissertations, presentation skills, database and using Zotero, Mahara and Microsoft Excel. Individual help can also be booked for everything related to digital IT skills for study.

Statistics support

Statistics is an area in which tutors have found that students ask for extra tuition. The Student Success Team can provide individual sessions and group workshops that run alongside academic teaching.

Success Coaches

Our Success Coach Team works with your course and exams teams to reach out and invite students for tailored 1-to-1 sessions. They will check how your studies are going, and discuss ways to empower you to access the support you need to achieve success.

The team also regularly runs workshops on healthy study habits like time management, organisational skills, beating procrastination, increasing confidence and examination preparation.

STUDENT SUCCESS ADVISORY BOARD (SSAB)
